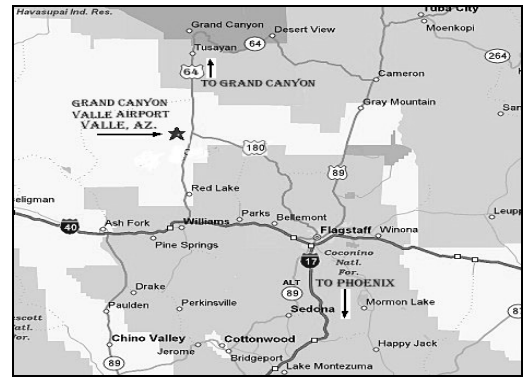

Vendor Contract Terms and Conditions

Reserving Space

Full payment accompanied with application is required to reserve space. Thunder Over the Coconino Fly-In reserves the right to relocate Vendors either before or during the event. The Vendor agrees that such relocation does not nullify the Vendor's obligation to pay the vendor fee. No refunds of payment will be made after May 29, 2010. Requests for refund must be made in writing or via e-mail to info@valleairport.com. Vendors must be prepared to provide proof of insurance upon request and any food vendors must have acquired their health food license prior to arrival.

Cleanup/Late Arrival

All Vendors are required to exhibit the full day of the Fly-In. Vendors must check in no later than 7:30 AM Saturday August 28, 2010 and be completely set up by 7:45 AM. **Any late arrivals, (after 7:30 AM) will incur an additional non-refundable \$25.00 fee.** Vendors are required to keep their space clean and orderly during and at the close of the event. Rubbish must be placed in refuse containers (centrally located). Vendors are required to man their exhibits/spaces and actively promote their products/services during the hours of 8 AM – 4 PM Saturday August 28, 2010. The official closing of your exhibit is Saturday August 28, 2010 at 4 PM. Only then may you begin to dismantle your exhibit/booth for departure.

Fees & Passes

Your Vendor fee includes two (2) passes for entrance onto airport facility. Additional passes may be purchased prior to the event at the admission gate. All vehicles should off-load items and then park in the general admission parking lot, prior to 7:45 AM Saturday August 28, 2010.

Vehicle Access to Vendor Area & Installation of Display

Vehicle access for set up may begin prior to 7:30 AM Saturday August 28, 2010. During the event, NO vehicle will be allowed in the Vendor area from 7:45 AM until 4 PM. Vendors must provide own tables, chairs, canopies or any other display items needed for installation of their booth, at their own expense.

Nature of Exhibits

All Vendors will have prior approval once application accompanied by paid fees is received and only the product(s) described on your application shall be allowed.

No coin operated games of chance or material bearing off-color sayings or images will be allowed. All items offered by Vendors must be in good taste.

Noisemakers, disruptive audio, flashing signs or other attention getting devices will not be allowed unless prior approval is obtained from the Fly-In manager. Complaints received regarding abuse will result in removal of such devices.

No weapons, noisemakers, or fireworks will be permitted (i.e., water guns, knives, poppers, etc.)

Subletting Space is Prohibited

Vendors shall not sublet any space in whole or in part, nor display any goods other than those manufactured, licensed, rented or sold by the Vendor in the regular course of business. In no event, shall Vendor grant to any person or company, permission to share their Vendor space.

Solicitation of Business

Those persons or firms who are bonafide commercial Vendors by virtue of paying for space and being a party to this agreement will confine solicitation to their display area. All signs and products will be kept within the confines of your Vendor space. No flyers or other promotional materials may be distributed on the grounds (including parking lots).

Camping

Camping in any Vendor space is prohibited. Dry camping is available, **with prior approval**, in the general admission area for RV or tent camping.

Security Liability – Public Liability

Thunder Over The Coconino Fly-In cannot assume any liability for losses by theft, fire, wind, water, accident, or loss or injury of property or person, including Vendors and/or employees. Vendors must ascertain that their public liability and employee compensation policies include coverage on the public entering their area and their employees for the period that they are either on or leaving the Fly-In site.

Safety

NO smoking, explosives, flammable or other dangerous items will be allowed in the Vendor areas, other than as needed for cooking only by Food Vendors. Decorations must be fire-resistant. Vendors utilizing open flame must furnish appropriate safety equipment including a fire extinguisher with a current inspection certificate.

Electrical

Thunder Over the Coconino Fly-In does not provide electricity, water, phones or lighting. Generators are permitted with OUTSIDE Vendors ONLY, provided they are quiet and do not interfere with the Fly-In or other vendors. String lights and BATTERY operated lanterns are acceptable and encouraged for added lighting.

Arizona Sales Tax
